PROJECT LIKE, a Houdini FUN Series Project



For the light colour, I created a gradient multi colour texture that I simply masked with an animated white to black gradient that reveals different colour tones as the animation goes along. In postproduction, I altered the natural video flow and mixed it with some simple metallic audio effects.




